## Large Group Volunteers

**Large Group Hosts** welcome the kids, go through announcements, and lead a game or interactive activity to get them primed for what is to come next.

**Worship Leaders** enthusiastically engage kids (and adults!) in worship of God through song and prayer.

**Storytellers** communicate God's story in such a way that it becomes unforgettable to a child. **Tech Volunteers** run the sound, slides, and lighting for our elementary large group.

**Craft Leaders** help our kids to explore their creativity by making something to connect with what they have been learning.

**Gym Leaders** help our kids to actively engage with what they have been learning.

## **Relationship-Building Roles**

**Nursery leaders** care for our babies so that they know that church is a safe place where they are loved.

**Toddler leaders** play with kids and start introducing short stories, songs, and activities.

**Preschool leaders** play with kids, have a short story time, and then wonder through the story together.

**Elementary small group leaders** get to connect with a small group of kids to help them feel like they belong. They wonder through the Bible with the kids by engaging their interests and playful exploration.

## **Lobby Volunteers**

**Greeters** help with check-in and check-out for elementary kids.

**Registration** volunteers man the registration desk and also watch the self sign-in stations to see if families need help or to replace labels.

**Service Directors** lead the early childhood volunteer team time before the service and make sure all classrooms have what they need. They help direct families where to go.

**K-3 Service Directors** help support the elementary programming. They help to greet kids and help them engage with others. They assist small group leaders when kids need to go for a drink or to the washroom. They are available to help communicate with parents if needed. They will also help with check-out.

## **Other opportunities**

**Cleaners and organizers** come during the week to tidy and organize the supplies from Sunday. A couple of hours would be needed every week and the time can be flexible. This position could be shared with others.

The **Creative team** helps to make our environments irresistible to kids and their families. This is a flexible time commitment as different projects come up at different times. Some things may be able to be done from home. The **Special Events team** helps to put on exciting events for our kids and families. They will meet together to plan and put together events like Trunk or Treat and Easter Jam. This is a flexible time commitment as different events come up at different times.
