


### INTERIM WORSHIP ARTS DIRECTOR

#### **Position Overview**

Lakeview Church is seeking a musically gifted leader to give leadership and administrative support to our worship teams. The purpose of this position is to lead, organize, and schedule our worship teams for Sunday services. The right person will be asked to maintain our worship culture, and handle essential operational tasks within a flexible, part-time capacity.

**Reports To:** Lead Pastor

**Position Terms:** Part-time, interim position (minimum 3 months). Salary to be negotiated.

**Expected Hours of Work:** 20 hours / week.

#### **CORE RESPONSIBILITIES**

## **Oversee Worship Arts Teams**

- Lead Sunday service musical worship twice a month.
- Coordinate worship team rehearsal twice a month.
- Liaison with volunteer worship team leaders.

## **Worship Arts Administration**

- Schedule and book musical volunteers.
- Schedule and book technical volunteers.
- Arrange and select worship songs.
- Prepare sheet music and in-ear tracks for musicians.

#### **Sunday Service Setup**

- Setup musical instruments.
- Coordinate cable connections with technicians.
- Strip stage of equipment.

#### **Christmas Eve Production**

- Work with Lead Pastor to oversee production for three Christmas Eve services.
- Schedule and book musical volunteers.
- Schedule and book technical volunteers.
- Coordinate worship team rehearsal.

## **Musical Leadership**

Leading a team of musicians in a coordinated manner to provide an engaging musical experience for a wide audience.

### **Planning and Organizing**
